

## **AICAE Scholarship 2007-2008 School Year**

All UNM Student Chapter members of the American Indian Council of Architects and Engineers (AICAE) are invited to submit an application for the AICAE Scholarship for the school year 2007-2008. The AICAE national organization has graciously provided \$1000.00 to assist the University of New Mexico AICAE Student Chapter members in furthering their educational needs.

An AICAE Selection Committee, comprised of AICAE professional members, has been designated as the body to select the scholarship recipient. The scholarship will consist of one, \$1000 scholarship, distributed in two increments of \$500.00 each at the beginning of the Fall 2007 and Spring 2008 semesters. The award is intended to cover costs of books, supplies, materials, academic fees or travel to be used for study at UNM.

Award winners will be selected before the end of September, and recognized at the Honors Convocation in October 2007.

Students must complete an application and an essay. **Deadline for applications is September 21, 2007.**

1. The applicant must be an enrolled member of the UNM AICAE Student Chapter. Membership applications can be found on the AICAE Student Chapter Website (<http://aicae.unm.edu>).
2. The applicant must be enrolled as a full time student during the period of the award.
3. The applicant must have a GPA of 2.75 or greater.
4. The applicant must submit an Unofficial Transcript.
5. The applicant must submit an essay indicating the following:
  - a. Personal academic goals.
  - b. Native American community involvement, and,
  - c. Any outstanding achievements.
